Dental Assisting Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Dental Assisting (DA) Program must be fully admitted to the college. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate*.

The Dental Assisting program has a competitive admission process. The selection criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **110 points**. See the Dental Assisting Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit:

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Spring Semester 2024. The College's document deadline for Spring Semester 2024 is **Friday**, **November 17, 2023**.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, **Friday, November 17, 2023**.

## Immunizations:

Chattahoochee Technical College does not require vaccinations as criteria for admission and enrollment of students; however, immunizations are required for college health programs by our clinical partners. Students may not complete clinical rotations without meeting clinical site immunization requirements. All required vaccinations must be complete prior to starting clinical practice. Students completing internships or practicums in other majors must adhere to all job site vaccination guidelines. Clinical and job site requirements can and do change without notice or input from the College.

## Application/Information Session:

All students must attend a Virtual Application/Information Session and complete a Program Application. Program applications are <u>only</u> given out at the Application Sessions. A schedule of the Dental Assisting sessions will be available at the beginning of Spring Semester 2024 and posted on the Dental Assisting webpage. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the session. ## Final Class Selection:

Final class selection is based upon the total number of admission points. The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.
