Getting started with GA Futures

Go to GAFutures.org

If you haven't already, create an account by clicking the icon at the top of the page. If you have one already, sign in with your existing information.

Navigate to 'Hope & State Aid Programs' on the top ribbon. Click 'State Aid Applications and Forms', then 'State Program Applications', and finally 'GSFAPP'.

Before you begin, review your GA Futures Profile to make sure your name, date of birth, and social security number are correct. The data is populated automatically into the application and **cannot be changed within the application**.

Welcome to the Georgia Student Finance Application (GSFAPP)

Step 1: Information should have populated from the profile tab. Check the information in your profile tab for accuracy; update your GA Futures profile if needed. Then, indicate your assigned gender at birth.

Step 2: Start by indicating your US Citizenship Status. If you're an eligible non-citizen, provide your permanent resident card number. If you're neither a US citizen nor an eligible non-citizen, you cannot complete the GSFAPP. Lastly, confirm if you hold a Bachelor's degree or higher and address questions regarding drug convictions.

Step 3: Start by confirming your Georgia Residency Status. If you've recently moved or aren't currently in Georgia, address residency-related questions. Declare your US Military status. The GSFAPP will then determine if parental information is required. Respond 'yes' or 'no' as needed.

Step 4: Sign and submit the application! The GSFAPP does not require a parental signature, and only the student should sign.

GSFAPP Quick Facts

- The GSFAPP will remain valid for 10 years. This application will only review you for GA State Aid.
- Male applicants must meet the Selective Service Requirement. To register or check your registration status, visit www.sss.gov
- Applicants must meet the Georgia residency requirement to be eligible for GA State aid and be in an eligible state aid program.
