## Technology

### Personal Computer

- Windows Operating Systems and Laptops are preferred
- External Mouse is needed for drawing programs
- o Speakers, mic, and webcam for audio and video participation
- Flash drive/Thumb drive recommended for file storage convenience
- Notes:
  - o Computer labs open to Interiors students at the Woodstock Campus
  - o Macs are not standard; some software (Revit) will *not* run on a mac
  - (See computer System Requirements posted from <u>AutoDesk</u> to review)

## Software

Most software programs used are available for free to students, with the exception of SketchUp.

- <u>SketchUp</u> Student Studio Version, currently available at \$55 per year
- Microsoft Office (via CTC student link)
- AutoCAD and Revit (download free from AutoDesk after enrollment in class)
- Adobe Photoshop (free on-campus) availability to CTC students enrolled in applicable classes)
- Miscellaneous use of 2020 Design, Chief Architect, Homestyler, etc. per class.
