ATI TEAS (Version 7)  Minimum composite score of 70  <b>Required by Friday, March 29, 2024</b>	Limited to 2 attempts per calendar year; minimum 30 days between attempts.  Students who achieve a minimum individual total adjusted score of <b>70</b> on the ATI TEAS are able to continue in the application process and take the ATI Critical Thinking Entrance Exam.	100
ATI Critical Thinking Exam  Minimum composite score of 70	Students must achieve a minimum composite score of <b>70</b> on the ATI Critical Thinking Exam. Qualifying students will be notified via their CTC student email to schedule this exam.	100
