Phlebotomy Technician Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Phlebotomy Program must be fully admitted to the college and considered program ready. The program admits students twice in a calendar year, every Spring and Fall Semesters. Students must be 17 years of age by the start of the program to enroll in the PHLT courses. Students will be required to provide immunization records and complete a background check and drug screen before they can participate in the clinical education required for this program.

Program Classes:

ALHS 1011 can be taken as a Pre-requisite or Co-requisite course

PHLT 1030 and 1055 must be taken in the same semester. These courses are offered both Spring and Fall semesters.

- PHLT 1030 will be offered in **Term B** (1st 8-weeks of the semester). Students must pass the PHLT1030 course to move on to the PHLT 1055 Clinical Practicum course.
- PHLT 1055 Clinical Practicum course will be offered in **Term C** as a 4-week rotation at a clinical facility.
 - The rotation schedule is 5 days/week, 8 hours a day or 4 days/week, 10 hours a day

Information/Application Session:

All students must attend an Information/Application Session to receive approval to register for the PHLT courses. Application sessions for the fall classes will be offered in the spring semester. A schedule of PHLT information/application sessions will be posted during the Spring Semester for the Fall cohorts and during the Fall Semester for the Spring cohorts.

Final Class Selection:

Final class selection is on a first-come first-serve basis. There are 15 seats available for the program.

Orientation:

The first 15 students who register for both PHLT 1030 and PHLT1055 will be in the Phlebotomy program for the following semester and will be the required to attend mandatory Phlebotomy Program Orientation one week prior to the semester start.

Immunizations:

Chattahoochee Technical College does not require vaccinations as criteria for admission and enrollment of students; however, immunizations are required for college health programs by our clinical partners. Students may not complete clinical rotations without meeting clinical site immunization requirements. All required vaccinations must be complete prior to starting clinical practice. Students completing internships or practicums in other majors must adhere to all job site vaccination guidelines. Clinical and job site requirements can and do change without notice or input from the College.
