Program Locations:

- A. Appalachian Campus (Jasper)
- B. North Metro Campus (Acworth)

Program Length:

- A. EMT
 - One semester (15 weeks)
- B. AEMT
 - 10 weeks

Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Emergency Medical Services Professions (EMSP) Program must be fully admitted to the college and considered program ready. No prerequisite courses needed. Students must be 18 years of age by start of clinicals. Students will be required to provide immunization records and complete a drug screen and criminal background check before they can participate in the clinical education required for this program.

EMT Courses:

Students will earn an EMT certificate by successfully completing the following courses. Students will then be eligible to take the NREMT exam to gain certification and licensure. After successfully completing these courses, students will also be eligible to enroll in the AEMT or paramedic program.

Immunizations:
