## Dental Assisting Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Dental Assisting Program must be fully admitted to the college. No prerequisite courses needed. Students must be 18 years of age by start of clinicals (Fall C Term). Students will be required to provide immunization records and complete a drug screen and criminal background check before they can participate in the clinical education required for this program.

**STEP 1:** Prior to applying to the Dental Assisting program, all prospective students must first apply via the website to the college, be admitted and have a student ID number.

## STEP 2: View Program Video Session – Mandatory

**Applicants must view the program video in order to submit a program application.** The video is located on our website by following these steps to reach the program page.

**Immunizations:**

Chattahoochee Technical College does not require vaccinations as criteria for admission and enrollment of students; however, immunizations are required for college health programs by our clinical partners. Students may not complete clinical rotations without meeting clinical site immunization requirements. All required vaccinations must be complete prior to starting clinical practice. Students completing internships or practicums in other majors must adhere to all job site vaccination guidelines. Clinical and job site requirements can and do change without notice or input from the College.

**Final Class Selection:**

Once the electronic application has been processed the required permissions to register for the Dental Assisting courses will be applied to your student account. Note you will not receive confirmation of this and it is your responsibility to register for the Medical Assisting courses. Registration is first come first served. The program does not employ a waiting list. There are 24 seats available for each cohort. A mandatory program orientation date will be posted in the student's welcome letter. All notification letters are emailed to Chatt Tech student email addresses. Once accepted to a cohort, students will be required to complete with that cohort.

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
