Program Locations:

- A. Appalachian Campus (Jasper)
- B. North Metro Campus (Acworth)

Program Length:

- A. EMT: 15 weeks
- B. AEMT: 10 weeks

EMT Program Admission:

Applicants must be fully admitted to the college and designated as program-ready; no prerequisite courses are required. Students must be 18 years of age by the start of clinicals and complete required immunizations, a drug screen, and a criminal background check prior to participating in clinical education.

AEMT Program Admission:

Applicants must meet all EMT Program admission requirements and hold a current Georgia EMT license and/or NREMT certification at the EMT level. An exception may be granted for students transitioning directly from EMT to AEMT within the same semester.

EMT Courses:

Students earn an EMT certificate upon successful completion of the following courses and become eligible to sit for the NREMT exam for certification and licensure. Graduates are also eligible to enroll in the AEMT or paramedic program.

Advanced EMT (AEMT) Courses:

Successful completion of an EMT course allows students to enroll in the AEMT program. Graduates are eligible to take the NREMT exam for certification and licensure.

Immunizations:

Chattahoochee Technical College does not require vaccinations as criteria for admission and enrollment of students; however, immunizations are required for college health programs by our clinical partners. Students may not complete clinical rotations without meeting clinical site immunization requirements. All required vaccinations must be complete prior to starting clinical practice. Students completing internships or practicums in other majors must adhere to all job site vaccination guidelines. Clinical and job site requirements can and do change without notice or input from the College.
