

Paramedic: Certificate, Diploma, and Degree

Program Overview:

- Paramedic courses are offered on two campuses: North Metro and Appalachian
- It takes four semesters to complete the paramedic courses
- Students must hold a current certification or licensure as an EMT, AEMT, or EMT-I to enroll
- There is a certificate, diploma, and degree option for paramedicine

Program Start:

- North Metro Campus: Spring Semester
- Appalachian: Fall Semester

Steps for Students Seeking Paramedic Program Admission:

- Be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College
- Choose a program of study:
 - *Paramedicine Certificate, Paramedicine Diploma, or Paramedicine Associate Degree*
- Attend a virtual information session and complete a program application. More information about sessions are posted on the paramedic webpage.
